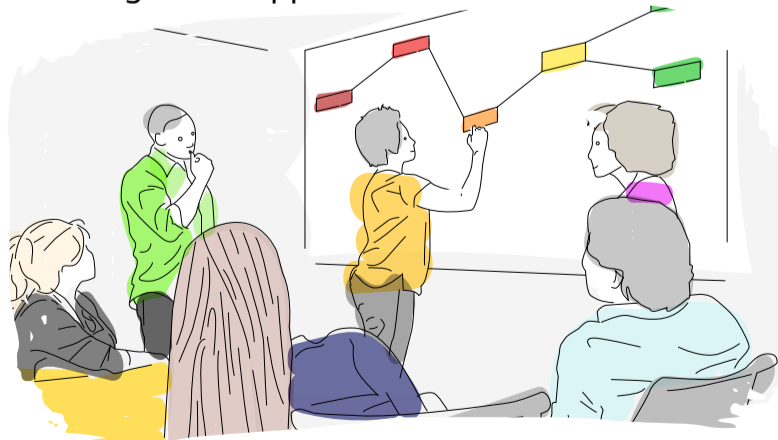
INVOLVE
